I am now on the Social club comittee at the Cultural Center and am doing an Andrijivskij Vechir type thing

(Evening of Fortunes) for adults but was hoping that maybe Spartanky could do it for Yunatvo again this year and then we could carry over to adult for the Social Club that evening for member s of the Center. It is during Pist or Advent and a nice event before Xmas on a Friday night. What do you think?

Lastly, I have noticed that Spartanky do not wear their odnostroyi during typical Plastovi Sviata like Vidkryttia Plastovoho Roku or other Sviata that our children are dressed. I know that it is a personal thing but can we find out what is proper and who should actually be in their odnostroyi and why? Also a hutirka on Odnostrij and how it should look might be of value since some people really seem to be lax these days. Plus we have some kandydantky removed from Plast for many years or even from Sum that may not know about this. Am I being too nitpicky?

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# **Needs for Pochatkoviy Tabir**

We now do maystryvannia and have pidvechirok outside, in back of the barrack, under gazebos. The two old picnic tables that we use need to be replaced, as they have weathered over the years, and kids are getting a lot of splinters. I would recommend that these get replaced by resin, collapsible picnic tables. They cost ~\$100 each at BJ's, for a 6 foot table (with attached benches).

We also use a buffet table (6 foot, collapsible) as a staging surface for maystryvannia and pidvechirok. I have left mine behind at Vovcha, but would like to replace it. Cost is ~\$50 at BJ's.

I have also left my two 8'x10' gazebos at tabir, which we have used for the past four years. I have recently purchased a replacement for myself, \$94.40 at BJ's. If I could get reimbursed for this, it would be great, but if not – no problem, it will be a donation for tabir.

We should get a large resin outdoor storage bin. That way, we can keep all of our taborovi supplies separate from other Vovcha items. The existing storage room (shtab), which is accessible from the outside, now contains some of our stuff, some Vovcha stuff, and some speakers/amplifiers. I would recommend a large bin with a combination lock, with only Spartanky knowing the combination. Cost is ~\$---.

And a small plastic organizer for office supplies. Cost is ~\$10.

One issue is that these items are quite large, and it will be challenging to get them to Vovcha. I do not have a vehicle to transport them, nor would I recommend that someone drive these up from home. Does anyone have any suggestions?

reject Wild What a wonderful newsletter!! I love to be reminded of all the good stuff we all do as a team. It makes me very proud and happy to be a part of this group that graciously does so much.

Unfortuntely, I will not be able to attend schodyny because we will be visiting my Alia who's been away all semester. But with regard to the recycling program, I have been in contact with Ivanka Iwaskiw (whom I am copying) since she is has access to programs, catalogs and web sites since she is an environmental engineer herself or close to the profession as an engineer.

I have attended the main OTK meeting and formally announced that we intended to support recycling at Vovcha and have outlined "Phase 1" of the program.

Phase 1 basically looks like this:

- 1. Spartanky agreed at Rada 2006 to provide receptacles (2 novak camp, 2 in yunak camps, 1 in U2, 1 in Pochatkovij, 1 in kitchen area and 1 near kramnychka) primarily for water bottle (1 and 2 type) collection. The kitchen would also have bins or receptacles for glass and metal. Kramnychka would have for aluminum cans as well. Ivanka has access to catalogs as estimated prices for these receptacles. We can label them with Spartan colors and with catchy slogans like "plastuny chystiat svit" or the like.
- 2. We need to write a simple program to implement into doskil which is weekend or Friday before tabir starts so our vychovnyky are aware of this new Recycling Program. It will be simple and will possibly suggest a vmilist during tabir.
- 3. Dyszhurnij at the kuchnia will need to be instucted as to how to try and recycle around the kuchnia without stepping on any toes. Cans and metal in certain bins, glass in others.
- 4. We will try to replace the styrofoam plates and heavy plastic cups with paper products. OTK agreed with me where we will suggest this for the next order and use up the stuff already bought probably in high quantities. Our approach will be to try to suugest and encourage a change this Phase 1 period. We don't want the kitchen saying those Spartanky want us to do so much more work. We would like everyone to feel they are doing this for the cover the \$ D those Spartanky want us to do so much more work. We would like everyone to feel they are doing this for the good of the tabir and the earth. This is the real Plastova idea, right?
- 5. Chrystia Stasiuk as hnizdova said that possibly as an Earth Day project (April 25th) the boys hnizdo would make a giant poster (maybe 4ft by 6feet) that can permanately hang at Vovcha to display times required for various things to decompose ie. paper 3 months, plastics years, styrofoam 100 years etc. Should we copy this as a reminder to Chrystia?
- 6. Ivanka contacted the actual recycling center that is very near tabir and has some information on that. Our kurin will have to pick up the cost of the delivery at the end of tabir to drive to the Recycling Center. Hopefully we will be able to pay someone at the tabir to do this if we collect the receptables the last day of tabir ourselves or else pay someone else to do this. I suggest we get one volunteer Spartanka for every camp to pick up the container and be responsible to bring it by the kitchen. This would make it a team effort and not dump the responsibility on the Vovcha (OTK)staff which is exactly what I DO NOT want to do. Maybe NY hurtor could volunteer on this as well.
- 7. Maybe we could put a sentence or two into the final newsletter that goes out to parents regarding check in

procedures. Should we suggest that the kid bring those refillable water containers from campmore? Or we could mention that we are now recycling and expect parents to set the right example.

So that is Phase 1 in a nut shell. Phase 2 might be a better way of recycling of paper in administratsia for example or in the barracks during majstruvannia.

I hope Ivanka will be able to come and present her ideas and possibly the cost vs say Home Depot brand. I think the stuff in her catalogs might be more durable and will last longer as long as we store them for the winter.

Hope all is well and we make it through this.

### Basically:

Sport is the only activity that will not be scored toward the overall tochkyvanya for SV-2007. So, it is really up to you guys to complete the logistics. It has been decided already that track and field is it with a couple of team sports. HOWEVER, this does not mean that we are not working together.

I think the below questions can be answered as follows:

## **INDIVIDUAL SPORTS:**

I would recommend two groups (younger and older). It would not be fair for a 13 year old to compete against a 16 year old. I don't think it matters how you break up the groups as long as you keep track of the scores/times along with the name age of the participant. However, it probably would work better if you break in age groups to make it more competitive/fun. The second half of the day - bring out the top 5 in each event and conduct finals for each event/age group getting to 1st,2nd, and 3rd in each event.

I will bring the kids down after lunch in sport clothes (sunday) and you guys break them up as you see fit. I will provide you access on Saturday or Sunday, depending when you guys come - with a list of the unaku/unachku and age. It doesn't matter for the individual events where they are from.

## TEAM SPORTS:

We were thinking vollyball, tug-of war, relay races (age divided), etc..
You can pick depending on your thoughts or ideas. These will have to be stanuchadivided.

#### IN GENERAL:

Come up with a way to conduct these events from approx: 1:30 - 6:00. You might want to do individual sports first, then team sports, then finals for individual sports. You will have to break for pidvechirok, or the kuhnya can \bring out the pidvechirok out to the sports field - you can choose. I would recommend that the team sports be final elimination to not have finals (brackets maybey).

Each 1,2,3 will get a medal, bylava, or if you want to recommend - you can purchase and we will reimburse. You guys should probably get the awards so you can personalize them according to your kurin.

### THE OSELIA:

I have spoken already at length with Sonia Bokalo with matters other than sport. Please contact her for logistocs for the events. I am sure we can get the long

jump pit in order and high jump with mattresses, etc... Or you can tell her to get the track in shape during spring cleanup. The xmeli could help on saturday do some work, but we will be building the vatra - terenova hra, etc..

Last year there were approx 8 kurins for boys and girls split almost evenly with 80 boys and 80 girls. I would expect approx. the same.



Hope that all is well with you, and that your trip is going well. As you may know, Lida Mochula's fahter-in-law passed away last week. Vasyl Mochula was a major plastun in Passaic - it was a very moving panachyda and poxoron.
